No restricted ingredients

This material does not contain any substance restricted by the current IFRA Standards. Phenethyl alcohol is not itself the subject of an IFRA Standard, and no category limit applies to it.

SECTION 4 — ANNEX 1 — IFRA CATEGORY DEFINITIONS

Below is an extract of the information published by IFRA describing the types of application covered by each IFRA Category. Fuller detail is given in the Guidance to the IFRA Standards, issued by IFRA.

IFRA Category	Product types
Category 1	Lip products of all types (solid and liquid lipsticks, balms, clear or coloured); children's toys.
Category 2	Deodorant and antiperspirant products of all types, including any product intended or reasonably foreseeable for use on the axillae or labelled as such (spray, stick, roll-on, under-arm, deo-cologne); body sprays, including body mist.
Category 3	Eye products of all types (eye shadow, mascara, eyeliner, eye make-up, eye masks, eye pillows) including eye care and moisturiser; facial make-up and foundation; make-up remover for face and eyes; nose pore strips; wipes or refreshing tissues for face, neck, hands and body; body and face paint, for children and adults; facial masks for the face and around the eyes.
Category 4	Hydroalcoholic and non-hydroalcoholic fine fragrance of all types (eau de toilette, parfum, cologne, solid perfume, fragrancing cream); aftershaves of all types except creams and balms; fragranced bracelets; ingredients of perfume kits and fragrance mixtures for cosmetic kits; scent pads and foil packs; scent strips for hydroalcoholic products.
Category 5A	Body creams, oils and lotions of all types; foot care products (creams and powders); insect repellent intended to be applied to the skin; all powders and talc, excluding baby powders and talc.
Category 5B	Facial toner; facial moisturisers and creams, including care products for beard and moustache.
Category 5C	Hand cream; nail care products including cuticle creams and nail lacquer remover; hand sanitisers.
Category 5D	Baby cream and lotion, baby oil, baby powders and talc.
Category 6	Toothpaste; mouthwash, including breath sprays; tooth powder, strips and mouthwash tablets.
Category 7A	Hair permanent or other hair chemical treatments, rinse-off (e.g. relaxers), including rinse-off hair dyes.
Category 7B	Hair sprays of all types (pumps, aerosol sprays); hair styling aids, non-spray (mousse, gels, leave-on conditioners); hair permanent or other hair chemical treatments, leave-on (e.g. relaxers), including leave-on hair dyes; dry (waterless) shampoo; hair deodoriser and hair perfume.
Category 8	Intimate wipes; intimate deodorant spray; tampons; baby wipes; wet toilet paper.
Category 9	Bar soap; shampoo of all types; rinse-off facial cleanser; rinse-off conditioner; liquid soap; body washes and shower gels of all types; baby wash, bath and shampoo; bath gels, foams, mousses, salts, oils and other products added to bathwater, such as bath bombs; foot care products where feet are placed in a bath for soaking; shaving creams of all types (stick, gels, foams); all depilatories, including facial, and waxes for mechanical hair removal.
Category 10A	Hand-wash laundry detergent, including concentrates; laundry pre-treatment of all types (paste, sprays, sticks); hand dishwashing detergent, including concentrates; hard surface cleaners of all types (bathroom and kitchen cleansers, furniture polish); machine laundry detergents with skin contact (liquids, powders), including concentrates; toilet seat wipes; fabric softeners of all types, excluding fabric softener sheets; other household cleaning products, including fabric cleaners, soft surface cleaners, carpet cleaners, furniture polish sprays and wipes, leather cleaning wipes, stain removers, fabric enhancing sprays and treatment products for textiles (starch sprays, fabrics treated with fragrance after wash, deodorisers for textiles or fabrics); floor wax; fragranced oil for lamp rings, reed diffusers, pot-pourri and liquid refills for non-cartridge air fresheners; ironing water (odorised distilled water); dry cleaning kits involving manual application on the textile.
Category 10B	Animal sprays applied to animals of all types; manual air freshener sprays, including aerosol and pump; aerosol and spray insecticides.
Category 11A	Feminine hygiene conventional pads, liners and interlabial pads; baby diapers; incontinence pants and pads; dry toilet paper.
Category 11B	Tights with moisturisers; scented socks and gloves; dry facial tissues; napkins; pillow spray; paper towels; wheat bags; paper or protective facial masks, such as surgical masks not used as a medical device; solid fertilisers, pellet or powder.
Category 12	Candles of all types, including encased; laundry detergents for machine wash with minimal skin contact (liquid tabs, pods); automated air fresheners and fragrancing of all types — concentrated aerosol with metered doses (0.05–0.5 mL per spray), plug-ins, closed systems, solid substrate, membrane delivery, electrical, powders, fragrancing sachets, incense, cartridge liquid refills, air freshening crystals, solid non-aerosol car diffuser; air delivery systems; cat litter; cell phone cases; deodorisers and maskers not intended for skin contact (fabric drying machine deodorisers, carpet powders); dry cleaning kits placed in the dryer; dryer sheets and fabric softener sheets; fuels; insecticides such as mosquito coil, paper, electrical and for clothing, excluding aerosols and sprays; joss sticks and incense sticks; dishwash detergent and deodorisers for machine wash; olfactive board games; paints; plastic articles, excluding toys; scratch and sniff; scent packs; scent delivery systems using dry air technology; shoe polishes; toilet rim blocks; toilet gel; scent beads.

Provenance and validity

This certificate is issued by Veriscents as the supplier of the repackaged material. It restates the conformity assessment and category limits established for this material under the IFRA Standards, together with the category definitions published by IFRA. It is derived from the supplier certificate of conformity for this material (version 1, issued 19 February 2025). The IFRA Standards are revised periodically — confirm that this certificate reflects the current Amendment before relying on it for a compliance decision.
